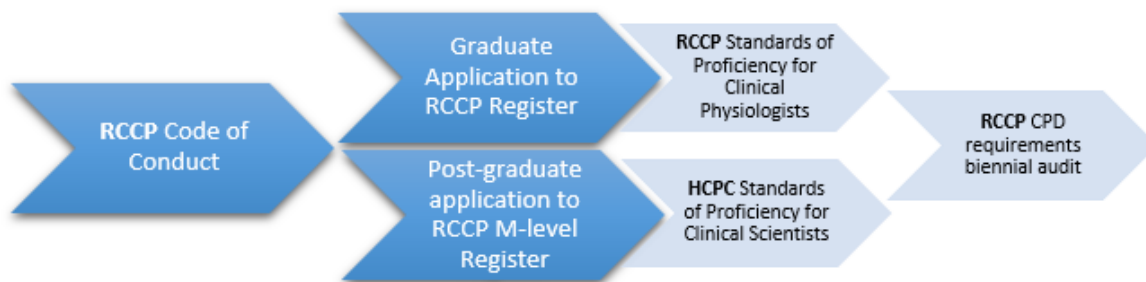


Post-graduate Masters (M)-Level RCCP Registration

The post-graduate M-level application process includes evidencing clinical and professional practice at post-graduate level (M-level) by way of a detailed report. The report details your record of training and experience gained to demonstrate the attainment of personal competence across a range of defined activities at M-level. This report is also supported by a reference from the current Head of Service or Lead Clinician. Applications are scrutinised by senior professional body M-Level RCCP registrants following an agreed format.

This supporting evidence must be at the level of [HCPC](http://www.hcpc-uk.org) Standards of Proficiency (Clinical Scientists) for the M-level register and for neurophysiologists applying also for Chartered Scientist status, at the level of the CSci Standards required for registration through the ANS. The diagram below demonstrates The Standards applicable at graduate and post-graduate (M-level) registration:



There are 4 routes to enter the M-level register and the route you take will be dependent on your academic level:

- [Route 1](#): This route is available for current RCCP registrants who **have** a *professional body recognised post-graduate qualification at M-level*
- [Route 1A](#): This route is available to **non** RCCP registrants who **have** a *professional body recognised post-graduate qualification at M level*
- [Route 2](#): This route is available for RCCP registrants who **do not have** a *professional body recognised post-graduate qualification at M level*
- [Route 2A](#): This route is available to **non** RCCP registrants who **do not have** a *professional body recognised post-graduate qualification at M level*

If you have a recognised professional body Master's Degree, route 1 is likely to be your route of entry. If you do **not** have a recognised professional body Master's degree, then route 2 is your likely route of entry. Routes 1A and Route 2A are for applicants who are not currently on the RCCP graduate level register.



All applicants are required to have been working at a post-graduate level (M-Level) for a minimum of 2 years to be considered for the M-Level Register (CSci applications through the professional body ANS are required to have been working at M-level for 4 years prior to application).

The RCCP post-graduate **M Level** register recognises that many experienced Clinical Physiologists are qualified and practicing at, or above, [NHS Career Framework 6 Specialist Practitioner level](#). Currently only **GI Physiologists, Neurophysiologists** and **Sleep Physiologists** can apply to this register currently.

This will then open the '**Notice of Interest Form**' for you to complete and submit.

Please note that application submissions will take between 3-6 months to process dependent upon the completeness of the information provided.
