

RCCP GUIDANCE FOR INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

This process is aimed at enabling applicants who currently live outside the UK but aim to obtain employment in the UK to register as a clinical physiologist with RCCP.

You will be informed of specific requirements for acceptance onto the Register. This may include evidence that an appropriate level of English language has been achieved. The minimum overall level for registration with RCCP is 7.0.

The process is as follows:

1. Complete the RCCP Standard Application Form on the website (www.rccp.co.uk)
2. Your application will be assessed by a scrutineer
3. If not accepted you will be informed within 28 days
4. If you are accepted you will receive a letter confirming your provisional acceptance onto the Register (please note – the letter does not confer any right to work in the UK)
5. You will be informed that you have a period of 6 months from taking up the post as a clinical physiologist to submit a reference from your employer confirming your competency to perform the identified role
6. Full registration will then occur
7. If you fail to submit a reference, you will be informed and your name will become publicly available on the Register as a failed application.
